Play games that involve numbers, such as bingo, dice, card games, dominoes and board games. Play 'Guess My Shape' – you think of a shape, and your child asks you questions in order to guess the shape. You can only answer 'yes' or 'no'.

Whatever your age, songs can be an enjoyable way of practising number skills. Try a backwards counting song like '10 in a Bed'.

Play games with coins make different totals with different coins. Please ensure that the coins are cleaned first.
